STAYING SAFE IN WINTER -ICE SAFET

NEVER GO ONTO THE ICE.

There is no way of knowing whether it will take your weight/how thick the ice is/how cold, deep and fast the water beneath is.

KEEP A SAFE DISTANCE FROM THE EDGE.

Fallen leaves and snow could obscure the water's boundary and cause slippery surfaces.

CHECK FOR SAFETY SIGNAGE.

It is there to warn you of hazards you may not be aware of.

ALWAYS SUPERVISE CHILDREN.

KEEP DOGS ON LEADS AND DON'T THROW BALLS/STICKS FOR THEM NEAR

ICE. Never go on to the ice to rescue a dog.

IN AN EMERGENCY, CALL 999 AND GIVE CALM AND ACCURATE INFORMATION ABOUT THE SITUATION AND LOCATION. Never go on to the ice to help.
