# STAYING SAFE IN WINTER -ICE SAFET

### **NEVER GO ONTO THE ICE.**

There is no way of knowing whether it will take your weight/how thick the ice is/how cold, deep and fast the water beneath is.

#### **KEEP A SAFE DISTANCE FROM THE EDGE.**

Fallen leaves and snow could obscure the water's boundary and cause slippery surfaces.

## CHECK FOR SAFETY SIGNAGE.

It is there to warn you of hazards you may not be aware of.

#### **ALWAYS SUPERVISE CHILDREN.**

KEEP DOGS ON LEADS AND DON'T THROW BALLS/STICKS FOR THEM NEAR

**ICE.** Never go on to the ice to rescue a dog.

IN AN EMERGENCY, CALL 999 AND GIVE CALM AND ACCURATE INFORMATION ABOUT THE SITUATION AND LOCATION. Never go on to the ice to help.
